Creating a Ticket for assistance with AVP

<u>There are two methods in which to create a Ticket with FosTech</u> <u>Support for assistance with AVP.</u>

- The first, and most accurate way is to go to our support site at <u>support.fostechsolutions.com</u> and enter in the proper information in each required field. Followed by a detailed description of what the issue is, or what service you are requesting.
- The other option is to send an email to our support email address at support@fostechsolutions.com. If you choose to send the Ticket in through email, please ensure that you include the following information:
 - Your name
 - Your Company's name
 - The name of the individual/participant in AVP that is affected by the issue, if there is one.
 - $\circ~$ A detailed description of the issue or of the service being requested.
 - A good way to contact you (email/phone number), and a time that you will be available.

Whichever option you prefer to use to submit Tickets, we ask that you only include one issue/request per Ticket. If you have multiple items, please submit a Ticket for each one. Once a Ticket has been received in our system through the email option, you will receive a confirmation email. If you do not receive one, then the Ticket did not successfully get entered and we will not know that you need assistance. Below is an example of the email you should receive.
